Our Service Group bottom left collected new toys for the Pediatric Oncology Patients at St. Joseph's Hospital in Paterson for the Spring Party.

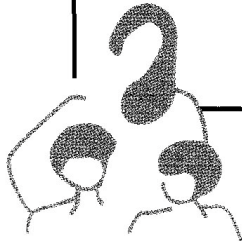

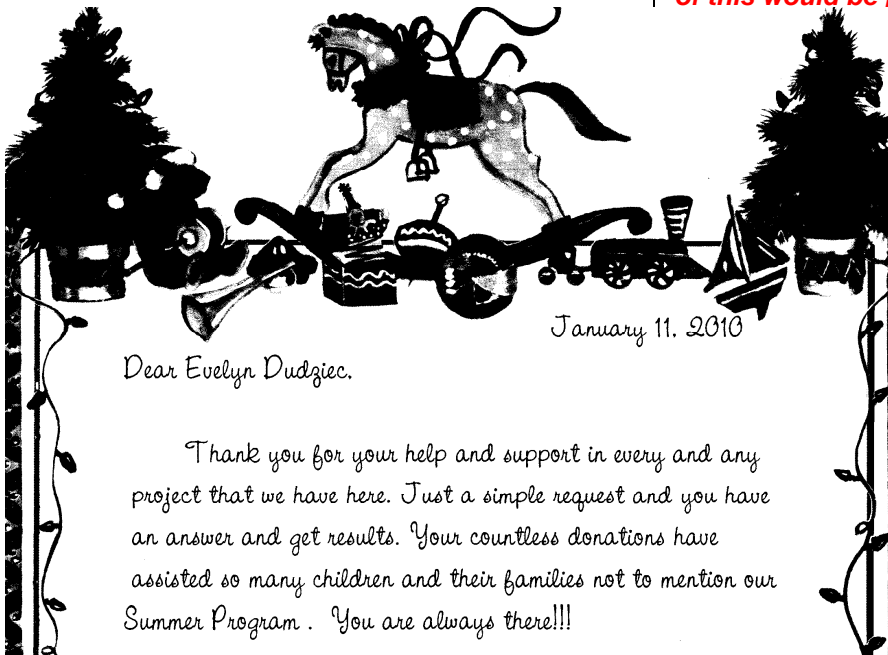
