KATIE'S HOUSE, Inc., was founded in 2001 by Evelyn and Conrad Dudziec. Evelyn was the leading force of the organization and Conrad was the quiet strength and support who helped to build and maintain the Katie's House residential homes.

Katie, now 37, is a young woman with intellectual disabilities who will never be able to live on her own. Her parents realized her vulnerability and their own mortality. They asked: "Who will care for our charming daughter when we are gone? We want her to live, comfortably cared for, happy and safe. We want Katie to have a full life."

Together, Evelyn and Conrad created Katie's House, Inc., a Residential Home, built on love, for their daughter and other individuals with special needs.

HISTORY Evelyn and Conrad accepted Katie as a host child under Healing the Children when she was 2 weeks old. With many serious health issues, Katie was not expected to live to reach her first birthday. Katie's birthparents were unable to provide Katie with the medical treatment she needed. They released her for adoption to the Dudziecs when she was 3 years old.

Katie spent several years in and out of the hospital, but she proved the doctors wrong. Slowly, Katie progressed and at the age of 3, the feeding tube was removed because she now could eat by mouth. She walked independently when she was 4.

YEARS LATER, at the age of 11, Katie was diagnosed with Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. She spent 7 months going in and out of St. Joseph's Hospital Pediatric Oncology Center for intense chemotherapy. Again, Katie would prove she was strong by overcoming the cancer.

When Katie graduated from high school, Evelyn & Conrad wanted their daughter to experience a full and exciting life. As a young woman, Katie moved into the first Katie's House residence, and was able to live as independently as possible.

TODAY, Katie's House, Inc. has grown to include 4 Residential Homes, currently for 7 people in their 20s and 30s. Each residence has a carefully chosen House Manager. Each individual resident has a team of DSPs (Direct Support Professionals) to provide care when away from home.
